A regular meeting of the Bedford Public Library Board of Trustees was held on May 8, 2019 in the New Hampshire Room. The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. Grace Larochelle and Carla Ferreira joined the meeting from 9:15 a.m. to 9:50 a.m.

Secretary's Report – Minutes from the April 11, 2019 meeting were accepted and approved. **Treasurer's Report** – The Treasurer's report was reviewed and accepted. Old Business:

Library Walkway – The walkway replacement will begin on Monday, May 27.

Motion: Pam moved that the Trustees spend an additional \$145.00 for the equipment. Walter seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business:

Unattended Child Policy – Grace Larochelle and Carla Ferreira joined the meeting to discuss the policy. The draft will be modified based on the discussion. The policy will be voted on at the next meeting.

Bedford Garden Club Proposal – The Garden Club would like to enhance the garden on the lower level and would like us to contribute funds to the project. Peter and Kirk put a sleeve under the walkway for the irrigation.

Motion: Pam moved that the Trustees support the Bedford Garden Club project to re-landscape the garden at the lower level of the library in the amount of \$550.00. Tony seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Library Garden Supplies – The staff grows cutting flowers in the raised beds and would like to continue with it this summer.

Motion: Pam moved that the Trustees fund up to \$100.00 for plants/supplies for the garden. Tony seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
