A regular meeting of the Bedford Public Library Board of Trustees was held on December 12, 2019 in the New Hampshire Room. New Business:

Facilities – Peter scheduled a company to clean out the gutters. They were repositioned several months ago for better drainage. With the snow fall, we lost some of our parking spaces. DPW came and did some clean up. **Landscaping** – The leaf blowers that were used for cleanup this year blew all of the mulch away. This spring the trustees may need to consider assisting with replacing the mulch for the Garden Club.

Story time with police officer – Mary Ann shared information about the police story time.

3-D Printer Replacement – The filament we use is cornstarch based, and thus does not require ventilation. There has been a lot of demand for printing recently, and our printer has recently stopped working again. Caitlin has succeeded in fixing it in the past, but it is unable to be fixed now. She is recommending that we replace it with a Flashforge printer. The Friends would like to purchase the new 3-D printer for \$799.
